

Phone Book ^{Feb 11-1965} Address Should Be 'Burnsville'

"Your address in the phone book should be changed now to Burnsville", according to Chet Wharton, Northwestern Bell Telephone Yellow Pages Representative.

Wharton made this statement at a recent meeting of the Burnsville Chamber of Commerce while announcing that new telephone directories are now being prepared. The Post Office Department permits use of the name Burnsville as a mailing address (zip code 55378).

Wharton explained that the best way to effect the change was for each person and business firm to call the telephone company office (FE 2-4112) and notify them how their address should appear. "Everyone should read their latest phone bill as that is how your listing will be printed," said Wharton, "unless the business office is advised of your changes."

"Also, Burnsville will be spelled in full in the new directories, and not abbreviated as with Savage (Svge)", Wharton noted, "which is our way of boosting Burnsville!".
